Linda Bradford Ratschke and Laurence Connors introduced in Street Smarts the two-period rate of change (ROC). It was inspired by George Douglas Taylor, who in the 1940s wrote the Taylor Book Method. In his work, Taylor sets down a method for determining the short-term trend, through counting of cycle days, to form the basis for determining whether to buy, sell, or sell short.

Time charts represent price action in terms of time: a new bar (or candlestick, line section, etc.) is plotted after completion of a certain time period (called aggregation period). For example, the 1y D bar chart plots the price action for one year, marking Open, High, Low, and Close prices on the daily basis.
