The in-text citation for a website without an author is noted with the first noun phrase or words in the title in quotations and parenthesis, followed by a period. Unless the website includes numbered paragraphs or sections, you should not include any additional information.

A parallel citation to an Internet source may be provided if it substantially improves access to the source. Follow the regular rules for citing the source and then add the parallel Internet citation.

To cite websites, the most important components are the author (whether an individual or institution), the date, the title of the page, and the url for the site. For all online scholarly journals, provide the author (s) name (s), the name of the article in quotation marks, the title of the publication in italics, all volume and issue numbers, and the year

of publication. Include a DOI if available, otherwise provide a URL or permalink to help readers locate the source.

Entry in an Online Dictionary, Thesaurus, or Encyclopedia with a Group Author Note: An online dictionary, thesaurus, or encyclopedia may be continuously updated and therefore not include a publication date (like in the example below). If that's the case, use "n.d." for the date and include the retrieval date in the citation.

The source information required in a parenthetical citation depends (1) upon the source medium (e.g. print, web, DVD) and (2) upon the source's entry on the Works Cited page. Any source information that you provide in-text must correspond to the
